



## CORPORATE ACTIVITIES

### **WOODLAND SURVIVAL**

This activity is good for teams of 14 – 100 people and will last two hours or longer, depending on the team's requirements.

Teams will meet and select a leader; each team leader is given an envelope containing instructions which typically include:

- Make a fire
- Collect and boil some water
- Cook a meal (typically, potatoes, vegetables, eggs and trout will be provided)
- Make your camp habitable (makeshift tables, chairs and vases with flowers etc)  
Bedding can also be added (possibly bracken/grass/straw)
- Make a flagpole and attach a flag
- Make a stretcher; build a structure that can hold four members of the team without breaking

Materials such as rope, string, tarpaulin, a knife and a saw will be made available.

### **COUNTRY FAIR**

This event is for individuals or teams and will take place within the hotel grounds between mid-April and late September. In the event of bad weather, an indoor fair may be organised. *Subject to room availability.*

### **FERRET RACING**

Exactly what it says on the tin, we line up some ferrets, a bit of an obstacle course and away they go. Don't forget to cheer your chosen critter on!

### **WELLY THROWING**

In this event, each team member will get a welly boot and will have to throw the old boot as far as they can down the course. The top two distances thrown in your group (one male, one female) will be recorded and once all the teams have had a go, points will then be awarded to the farthest thrown. Everyone will get three throws of the welly boot.

### **APPLE BOBBING**

This is where we sort the wimps from the heroes. A big barrel of cold water and apples: get your head in there and pull them out with your teeth.

### **IN THE NETS**

In the old English sport that is cricket, this is used for practice. Test your new skills against a member of the Bovey Castle staff.

### **ARCHERY**

Every team member will get a number of arrows (dependant on group size) with which to accumulate the highest team score. At the end, all team members' points will be added up and the team with the highest score will get the points!

### **TUG-O-WAR**

The original team game for a last-minute challenge and a great way to finish off the day.

### **SPLAT THE RAT**

Like the old children's game, a beanbag rat gets dropped down a drainpipe and the team members take it in turns to whack it with a stick. The team with the highest hits at the end wins the points.

### SKITTLES

The original tenpin bowling game, the roots of which date back to medieval times. Each person has three balls to knock down as many pins as possible. Run throughout the day, the winner is the person with the highest score. If in teams, group scoring will take place.

### COCONUT SHY

Another traditional game, but a country fair favourite! Try and dislodge as many coconuts as possible with five balls. Those knocking down a coconut get to take it away. No scores necessary...but any outstanding throwers may be rewarded. Then again, they may not!
